Declared speakers will participate in the round table with short 5–7 minute presentations (with a brief presentation, if possible), succinctly presenting their scientific findings. The event will be held on the Google Meet platform.

Based on the round table's outcomes, the 4th issue of the "GPS (Green Power Solution) Bulletin" will be published, featuring abstracts relevant to the round table's topics.

To be published, materials must be sent by June 03, 2026, to the email: dakgps@pdatu.edu.ua. The file name must include the surname of the first author.

After compilation, the electronic collection will be uploaded to the university's repository at pdatu.edu.ua.

Abstract Formatting Requirements:

Materials should be 2–4 full A4 pages (297×210 mm), with 2.0 cm margins on all sides.

At the top center of the first page – TITLE OF THE SCIENTIFIC WORK (in capital letters).

Below (double-spaced) – surname and initials of the author(s), academic degree and title (if applicable).

Next line – author's email (no indent).

Next – institution represented by the author(s).

The abstract text should follow the structure: problem statement, main material, conclusions, references (if needed).

Font: Times New Roman, regular, size 14 pt, single line spacing, paragraph indent – 1.25 cm.




The author is responsible for the content and editing of the abstract.
